#### DIRECTORS' NOTES

Nearly a year ago, the Paly Performing Arts team met for the first time to discuss producing this musical. We knew that it had been nearly four years since a live musical had been done at the school, and that none of the current students had yet to have that quintessential high school musical experience. Because of that, we wanted to pick a show that was high-energy, full of fun, and would bring together our entire community: onstage, backstage, and in the audience!

Mamma Mia! Is a perfect choice in many ways. It's a musical about a celebration: a wedding that brings together family, friends, and long-lost-ex-lovers/potential fathers. It features beloved music from the Swedish band ABBA, disco nostalgia, and epic dance numbers. It gives our student performers and musicians a chance to play a more contemporary score than many Broadway shows, and our student designers chance to create something that falls somewhere in between a play and a rock concert. It's a legendary musical with a loyal fan base, including many students who were inspired to participate in their first show because of how much they love this piece.

Most of all, Mamma Mia! is a show full of heart. The characters in it teach us to accept ourselves instead of worrying about what anyone else thinks. They show us that family can be those related to you by blood, but it can also include the friends and loved ones who stick by your side no matter what. And they tell us to be true to ourselves, and especially to our dreams.
