

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

There are a lot of practical considerations in choosing a play each season: what script has enough roles to cast all of your interested students? What genre of play will give your designers a chance to practice working in different styles? What show will present different challenges and opportunities from the shows in the previous season? Radium Girls checks many of those boxes, pushing our cast and crew to work in a more realistic style than they had previously done, which includes incorporating historical research into their performance and design decisions. The script's commitment to exploring the many perspectives around this court case also means more opportunities to show off the talents of our students in a wide variety of roles.

But there are also reasons to do this show beyond the practical and logical. The story of these young women and the seemingly innocuous events that led to their illnesses is very moving, especially knowing that each of the girls we see in this play is based on a real person. Watching the reporters, doctors, and businessmen all fight to control the narrative about radium poisoning shows us how difficult it can be to uncover the truth, but also how vital it is for individuals to advocate for themselves and what they know.

Our students have displayed both passion and compassion while working on bringing this story to life. Their thoughtfulness, attention to detail, and enthusiasm about shining light on this piece of history have made the process both enjoyable and emotional. We're extremely proud of the maturity and empathy with which all of the cast, crew, and designers have acted, both onstage and off.
